

One Space Centennial Place

Centennial Place will serve as the community's one-stop shop for culture year-round: a space for residents to inform, learn, discover, create, and collaborate.

The new centre will provide a:

- new home for the Beaconsfield Library
- dedicated facility for many community groups and citizens of all ages
- café bistro
- versatile auditorium for events such as concerts and plays
- building designed to integrate harmoniously into the landscape of the park, and built according to LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) principles for energy efficiency and environmental sustainability, and an
- architectural design that incorporates the principles of universal accessibility

Following the recommendations of the Reimagining SPACE consultations, the multipurpose centre should be located on the east side of the site, so as to minimise the impact on the natural features of Centennial Park.

Centennial Place is part of a larger and longer-term project to revitalize the whole of Centennial Park and the adjacent Lord Reading property. Together with the redevelopment of the park and marina properties, Centennial Place will create a terrific new space for all seasons and all ages.
